### DESCRIPTION:

Picosulfate is the active ingredient in **Conspic®** which is a stool softening laxative for oral use

### PHARMACOKINETICS AND PHARMACODYNAMICS:

PHARMACOVINE ICS AND PHARMACOVINAMICS.

Sodium piocosulate is chemically bisodic salt of 4-4(2-Picotiliden) – bis (-Phenylsulphuric acid), It acts as a local laxative, metabolized by the colonic bacteria to the active compound bis (P-hydroxyphenyl) pyridy-2-methane, which stimulate the mucosa of the large intestine & causing colonic peristatisis. Sodium picosulfate is usually effective within 10-14 hours

Sodium picosulfate treats constination by enhancing bowel movement, it is indicated in:

- Acute and chronic constination
- Acute and contonic consupation
   Relief of exacutation in painful conditions such as hemorrhoids
   Pre and post operatively
   Preparation of barium enema
   Preparation of coton for proctosigmoidoscopy

# DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:

Adults: 1 - 2 tablets or 10 - 15 drops once a day

### Children:

2 - 3 drops once daily 2 - 5 drops once daily 6 - 10 Years:

The dosage may be adjusted under medical advice, according to the age and symptoms Drink 6 - 8 glasses of water daily while using any laxative

As directed by the physician

CONTRAINDICATIONS:
Conspite® is contraindicated in patients with iteum, intestinal obstruction, acute abdominal conditions like appendicities, acute inflammatory bowel disease and in severe dehydration. Known hypersensitivity to sodium picosulfate

PRECAUTIONS:

Protonged use of Conspic® should be avoided, Protong use may lead to diarrhoea, excessive loss & imbalance of electrolytes with possible hypokalemia, Children should not take Conspic® without medical advice, Do not use this laxative for longer than 1 week unless approved by doctor, Laxative may be habit-forming and can harm bowels if used too long

# ADVERSE REACTIONS:

ADVENSE REACTIONS:

Tollowing side effects related to the gastrointestinal tract may rarely be seen with sodium picosulfate use: abdominal pain, abdominal discomfort or distension, borborygmus, nausea, vomiting and diarrhoea

PREGNANCY AND LACTATION:
The safely of sodium picosulfate in pregnant and lactating women has not been established. Therefore sodium picosulfate should be administrated to pregnant women only when expected therapeutic benefits are considered to outweigh any possible risks associated with treatment.
