MOVERYL[®] Capsules (Celecoxib)

COMPOSITION:

PHARMACOLOGY:

Pharmacodynamics:

Moveryl[®] (Celecoxib) is a non steroidal anti-inflammatory drug that exhibits anti-inflammatory analgesic and anti-pyretic activities. The mechanism of action of Celecoxib is believed to be due to inhibition of prostaglandin synthesis, primarily via inhibition of cyclo-oxygenase-2 (Cox-2)

Pharmacokinetics:

Peak plasma levels of Celecoxib occur approximately 3 hours after an oral dose. In healthy subjects, Celecoxib is highly protein bound (~97%) within the clinical dose range. Its metabolism is primarily mediated via cytochrome P450 2C9 and excretion is predominantly n bile with little unchanged drug recovered in urine and feces

INDICATIONS AND USAGE:

Moveryl[®] (Celecoxib) is indicated for relief of the signs and symptoms of osteoarthritis and rheumatoid arthritis, for the treatment of primary dysmenorrhoea and for the management of acute pain, such as post-operative and dental pain

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:

Osteoarthritis: Recommended dose is 200mg/day as a single dose or as 100mg twice per day. Rheumatoid arthritis: 100 to 200mg twice per day. Management of acute pain and treatment of dysmenorrhoea: 400mg initially, followed by an additional dose of 200mg, f needed on the first day. On subsequent days 200mg twice daily as needed. No dosage adjustment is necessary in case of elderly or in-patients with mild hepatic or renal impairment OR

as directed by the physician

CONTRA-INDICATIONS:

Known hypersensitivity to the drug or other sulfonamides. It is also contra-indicated in patients who have experienced asthma, urticaria or allergic-type reactions after taking aspirin or other NSAIDs

WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS:

Celecoxib should not be used in patients having ulcer, asthma, urticaria or acute rhinitis No clinical experiences are available in patients with severe hepatic and renal impairment Safety of the drug during pregnancy and lactation and in children below 18 years has not been established

DRUG INTERACTIONS:

Celecoxib metabolism is predominantly mediated via cytochrome P 450 2C9 in the liver Co-administration of it with the drugs that are known to inhibit 2C9 should be done with caution

ACE inhibitors and Diuretics:

Concomitant use with ACE inhibitors or thiazides may reduce the antihypertensive or diuretic effects respectively

Aspirin:

Co-administration with aspirin increases the rate of GI ulceration or other complications

Fluconazole:

Fluconazole increases two fold the plasma concentration of Celecoxib

ADVERSE EFFECTS:

Headache, sinusitis, backache, abdominal pain, diarrhoea, dyspepsia, nausea, rash, insomnia etc. Rarely gastro-intestinal bleeding and anaphylactic reaction may occur

OVER DOSAGE:

Patients should be managed by symptomatic and supportive care following an over dose There are no specific antidotes

STABILITY: See expiry on the pack

INSTRUCTIONS:

Keep out of reach of children Avoid exposure to heat, light and humidity Store at 30°C or below Improper storage may deteriorate the medicine
