CONTRA-INDICATIONS:

PULSATE® must not be used in the following cases:

- Known allergy to macrolides, such as erythromycin, josamycin etc.
- In combination with ergot derivatives

Possible side-effects:

Gastro-intestinal reactions: Nausea, vomiting, stomach pain, diarrhoea, Allergic skin reactions, Dizzy spells

The dosage to be used is 5 to 8mg/kg/day in 2 separate doses and treatment should not prolong for more than 10 days

- Children between 24 and 40 kgs: 100mg morning and evening
- The tablets should preferably be taken before meals

ADMINISTRATION:

Disperse the tablet in 2 to 3 teaspoonsful freshly boiled & cooled water before use

Pulsate® is not recommended in Hepatic insufficiency, in combination with ergot derivatives, particularly ergotamine

CONTRA-INDICATIONS:

- Pulsate® must not be used in following cases:
 Allergy to macrolides, such as roxithromycin, erythromycin, josamycin etc.
 - In combination with ergotamine and dihydroergotamine
- 300mg tablet is contro-indicated in patients with severe hepatic insufficiency

The physician should be informed in the case of:

- Hepatic insufficiencyConcornitant administration of other drugs
- Pregnancy

INTERACTIONS WITH OTHER SIDE-EFFECTS:

- There is no clinically significant interactions with warfarin carbamazepine, cyclosporin, oral contraceptives containing oestrogens and progestogens
 - In healthy volunteers, a slight increase in plasma concentrations of theophylline levels which
- does not Aecessitate to alter the usual dosage, has been shown

SIDE EFFECTS:

Gastro-intestinal reactions:Gastric pain, nausea, vomiting, stomach pain, diarrhoea

Allergic skin reactions Dizzy sensations

Moderate increase in ASAT, ALAT and/or alkaline phosphatases. Exceptionally acute cholestatic

Possibility of fungal overgrowth
